Reference is made to the bids opened on April 15, 2024, City of Avon Park Glenwood and Crystal Lake Water Treatment Plant Chlorine System and Control Panel Improvements.

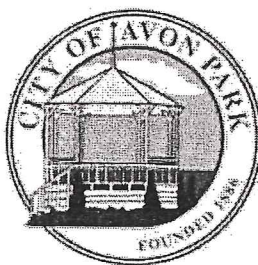
One bid of \$499,835 was received including \$10,000 owner's allowance. The project was sent out to bid twice and Odyssey was the only bidder both times. Odyssey has performed chlorine system improvements for the City at the other water treatment plant (Bell Street) and has a great standing with the City.

Attached for your review and approval is a copy of the bid from Odyssey and bid submittal requirement checklist. The apparent lowest and responsible bidder is Odyssey Manufacturing Company at \$499,835. Kimley-Horn reviewed the Bid submitted and recommends that the City of Avon Park accept the bid and recommends award to Odyssey Manufacturing Company.

Attached is Odyssey Manufacturing Co.'s ("Odyssey's") proposal for the subject bid. The purpose of this letter is to add additional clarifications to our proposal (we take no exceptions) and to respond to questions #6 - #8 and #10 of Section 00120 of the Special Conditions. First, Odyssey intends to use two subcontractors on this project:

- C&T Construction Services (Will Perform Concrete Work at Glenwood WTP and Ductile Iron Pipe Modifications at the Crystal Lakes WTP)
- Bill Gukeisen, Inc. (Will Provide the Control Panels, Vega Level Sensors, ICON VFD's and all SCADA hardware and programming)

The remainder of the work will be self-performed by Odyssey who will be installing (mechanical, electrical and plumbing) the chemical systems and related items. Odyssey has installed over 3,500 chemical systems in Florida including the sodium hypochlorite systems in the following nearby utilities: (1) City of Sebring (9 systems); (2) City of Lake Placid (2 systems); (3) Spring Lake Improvement District (3 Systems); (4) City of Frostproof (4 systems); (5) City of Avon Park (3 systems); (6) Sun N Lakes Improvement District (3 systems); (7) City of Lake Wales (5 systems); and (8) Polk County Utilities (87 systems).

(#6 Brief History of the Firm) - Odyssey Manufacturing Co. was incorporated in 1998 and began operations in late 1999. Our state-of-art bleach manufacturing facility in Tampa, Florida opened in March of 2000 and serves as our headquarters. A second manufacturing facility was opened on the east side of Orlando in January of 2008. In 2012, we started Odyssey Engineering Co. to provide engineering solutions (at arm's length when required) to our customers. In 2016, Odyssey signed an agreement with Olin to be their exclusive sodium hypochlorite distributor for Florida. Since then, Odyssey has constructed three rail terminals in Florida (Tampa, Lantana, Miami) where it receives railcars of sodium hypochlorite from Olin's Niagara Falls facility and distributes it via tankers. Odyssey also receives caustic, sodium bisulfite, potassium hydroxide and hydrochloric acid by railcar which it breaks down to distribute to its customers. We are also the leading provider of salt in Florida to the water and wastewater industry as we import salt from Chile by barge and store it in a 40,000-ton warehouse in Tampa. In addition to being a sodium hypochlorite manufacturer and chemical distributor, Odyssey is a licensed general and plumbing contractor which has designed and installed

over three thousand chemical systems in Florida at least half of which were sodium hypochlorite systems. Odyssey also has service contracts and performs service work on chemical systems for most of the utilities in Florida. Odyssey is the only entity in Florida who stocks chemical feed equipment, tanks, piping and spare parts. In addition, these parts and equipment are available to its customers on a 24/7 basis. Attached is an organization chart. Odyssey has five degreed engineers who perform project management for construction projects (everyone in the sales department) and four project superintendents (the technician specialists). We also have a related entity, Odyssey Engineering Co., which performs engineering design and permitting work as required for Odyssey's projects.

(#7 Description of Services Relating to the Governmental Sector) – As detailed above, Odyssey Manufacturing Co. is a full-service chemical provider to the Florida water and wastewater industry. We also design, install and service chemical systems for the Florida water and wastewater industry.



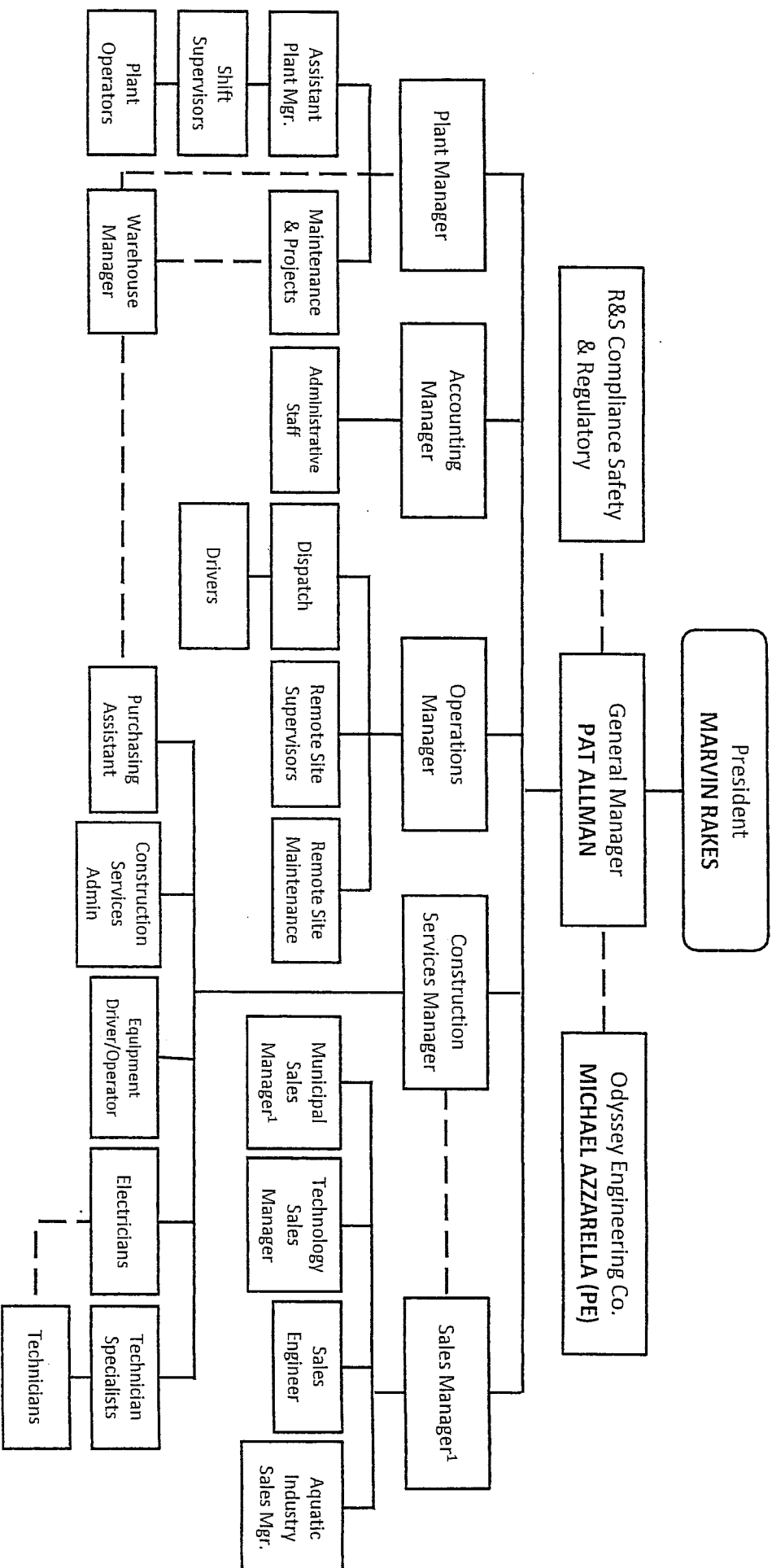
