



In accordance with the "Consultants Competitive Negotiation Act" (F.S. 287.055), City of Avon Park, Florida is seeking Statements of Qualifications from Florida registered firms to design, survey, permit, prepare construction documents, assist with construction bidding, and provide certifications for required clearances for a project that will consist of installing chlorine skids and program logic controls in the Crystal Lake Plant in accordance with approved design plans. Procure and replace 5,000 LF (linear feet) of existing asbestos pipe, landscaping and restoration included, in accordance with the approved design plans. Minimum Level of Service: 1) AIA Form G702/G703, or their substantive equivalent, certifying that the project, or a quantifiable portion of the project is. Procure and install 250 LF (linear feet) of 12-inch directional bore under US Highway 27.

The City of Avon Park is requesting Statement of Qualification proposals from qualified firms interested in providing Design and Engineering Services under the CDBG grant. Proposals will be accepted until 2:00 p.m. on September 2, 2022, in the office of the Purchasing Agent located at 110 E. Main Street, Avon Park, FL 33825.

Procurement and contracting for all services shall conform to CDBG guidelines as well as the state and federal regulation including 2 CFR, Part 200. All records shall be maintained in accordance with state and federal CDBG requirements.

All proposals shall remain valid for a period of ninety days (90) beyond the deadline for submission and may be extended beyond that time by mutual agreement. The City will automatically reject the response of any person or affiliate who appears on the convicted vendor list prepared by the Department of Management Services, State of Florida, under section 287.13(3)(b), Florida Statutes. City of Avon Park declares that all or portions of the documents and work papers and other forms of deliverables pursuant to this request shall be subject to review by the City. An award, if made, will be made to the Respondent(s) deemed to receive the highest ranking based on the evaluation criteria included in Section 2.0 of this Request for Proposal.

Each proposal will be reviewed to determine if the proposal is responsive to the RFQ. Proposals deemed to be non-responsive will be rejected without being evaluated. A responsive proposal is one which has been signed and submitted by the specified Proposal deadline, and has provided the information required to be submitted with the Proposal. While proper formatting, poor documentation and/or incomplete or unclear information may not be cause to reject a proposal without evaluation, such substandard submissions may adversely impact the evaluation of a Proposal. Respondents who fail to comply with the required and/or desired elements of this RFQ do so at their own risk.

The failure of a Proposer to submit acknowledgment of any addendum that affects the proposal price(s) may be considered an irregularity and may be cause for rejection of the proposal.

The Evaluation Committee shall review all proposals for compliance with the specifications and select a vendor(s) for recommendation.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, to waive in formalities in any or all proposals, to re-advertise for proposals, and to separately accept or reject any item or items and to award and/or negotiate a contract in the best interest of the City of Avon Park.
