Please let this letter serve as an official request to make a budget amendment to the above referenced grant by removing Deliverable 3 Task 7 and increasing Deliverable 2 Task 2.

On February 13, 2023 City Council discussed the fact that engineering and construction costs originally budgeted for the project were not sufficient. Jamison Tondreault's (P.E., Kimley Horn) initial estimate is based on preliminary opinions of probable costs which confirmed a budget shortfall of approximately \$100,000 - \$200,000 and possibly more. City Council directed staff to reach out to Florida Department of Economic Opportunity to see if it was possible remove Deliverable 3 Task 7 and increase Deliverable 2 Task 2, in the amount of \$50,000. After verifying with your office that this was possible, staff brought back before City Council on February 27, 2023.

On February 27, 2023 City Council approved to amend the budget and is in agreement with Kimley-Horn that procuring and installing 250 LF of 12-inch directional bore under US Highway 27 is not an essential project at this time, the City prefers other alternatives that are more important to improve fire flow. Deliverable 3 Task 7 is estimated to cost \$50,000 and the City requests that it be removed and the cost be added to Deliverable 2 Task 2.
